



Managed Service Provider Partner Program – MSP³ –

Program Update

Dear Managed Service Providers

I would like to thank you for your partnership with the Australian Cyber Security Centre as part of our new flagship initiative MSP³ and to take this opportunity to update you on some recent decisions regarding the program.

As you might be aware, when I launched MSP³ in January 2019 it was my intention to host a significant event to recognise your participation in the program and to publicly highlight the measures being taken to improve Australia's cyber resilience and supply chain security.

My intention remains to hold this event and showcase this critical new program. However, given the campaign for the federal election has now commenced I have decided to postpone the event to a date several weeks after the election is held on 18 May 2019.

I will be able to provide further information on an exact date for the event – most likely to be held in June 2019 – and also issue your invitation to attend in the very near future.

Noting the postponement of the event I have also decided to extend the closing date for businesses to apply to join MSP³ until 30 April 2019, and also for the return of the surveys to be extended to 30 May 2019.

The other milestone dates for MSP³ will also be adjusted to take these changes into account and this will soon be reflected in the information available on the program at www.cyber.gov.au.
